

## Integrated Urgent Care Service for East Surrey CCG, Guildford & Waverley CCG, North West Surrey CCG, and Surrey Downs CCG

Organisations with which this service must integrate:

Ashford & St Peter's Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust	A Foundation Trust since December 2010. The largest provider of acute hospital services to Surrey residents, serving a population of over 410,000 people living in the boroughs of Runnymede, Spelthorne, Woking and parts of Elmbridge, Hounslow, Surrey Heath and beyond. The Trust provides services across its two hospital sites – Ashford Hospital and St Peter's Hospital in Chertsey - and employs 3,700 members of staff.
CSH Surrey	CSH Surrey is a profit-for-purpose social enterprise community services provider. CSH Surrey provides therapy and community nursing services to the 290,000 population of mid Surrey. In addition to home-based services such as district nursing, CSH Surrey provides community health services for adults, children and their families in other community settings ranging from GP surgeries and community health centres to clinics, homes, schools and Community Hospitals.
First Community Health & Care	First Community Health & Care provides community healthcare services in East Surrey and the surrounding area comprising nursing and therapy teams, specialist care teams, children and family advice & support and a Rehabilitation Ward, Rapid Assessment Clinic and Minor Injury Unit at Caterham Dene Hospital. The organisation is a community interest not-for-profit social enterprise.
GP Federations in each commissioning geography	A Primary Care Federation is a formal or informal alliance of General Practices or General Practices and other community Primary Care providers, coming together to achieve and deliver a range of objectives, including the development, delivery and co-ordination of innovative new ways to provide high quality, patient-focussed services to the local community.
South East Coast Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust	The Trust responds to 999 calls from the public and urgent calls from healthcare professionals across all commissioners for the IUC service procurement.
Surrey & Borders NHS Foundation Trust	The leading provider of health and social care services for people of all ages with mental ill-health and learning disabilities and drug & alcohol services in Surrey. A partnership agreement with Surrey County Council allows the Trust to offer integrated health and social care. Services are provided in community settings, hospitals and residential homes with an emphasis on providing local treatment and support close to people's homes wherever possible.
Surrey County Council (and district and borough councils as appropriate)	Working in collaboration with commissioners and healthcare provider partners Surrey County Council is establishing comprehensive social care commissioning arrangements for adults and children to improve the quality of life and maximize opportunities for independent and supported living.
Surrey & Sussex Healthcare NHS Trust	The Trust provides emergency and non-emergency services to the residents of East Surrey, North-east West Sussex, and South Croydon, including the major towns of Crawley, Horsham, Reigate, Redhill, Oxted and Caterham. The Trust provides acute and complex services at East Surrey Hospital in Redhill and a range of outpatient, diagnostic and less complex planned services at Caterham Dene Hospital and Oxted Health Centre in Surrey.
